Since 1955, the Fairfield Beach Residents Association has played a critical role in addressing neighborhood concerns and providing a voice in town government.

As a member-based organization FBRA has always sought to represent and implement the interests and desires of the membership in maintaining and improving the Fairfield Beach vicinity.

- FBRA is focused on coastal environment including nuisance flooding on roads and drainage, long term flood and erosion challenges, pile and contaminant monitoring and oversight.
- FBRA strives to promote cooperation among homeowners and renters.
- FBRA is working with the Fairfield Police Department reviewing the noise ordinance for clarity and enforcement.
- FBRA has a program to assist residents in plating trees in communal areas.
- FBRA organizes volunteers for the Fairfield Firefighters 5 K race which raises money for charities.
- FBRA sponsors an annual giveaway of salt tolerant plants for all paid up members as a way of helping our community create a more erosion resistant environment.
- FBRA purchased and worked with the Fairfield Police Department to install a speed radar on Fairfield Beach Road.
- FBRA financed the lawsuit that resulted in restrictions on large crowds at Lantern Point, leading to a manageable student Clam Jam at the Penfield Pavilion.

While we have made many strides, we must continue our work to mitigate beach erosion, flooding, noise, speeding, rental house overcrowding and other ongoing problems in our neighborhood.
